Headteacher Update

Dear Parents,

As we approach the half term, we can see great progress in our classrooms but we have noticed that the children are starting to feel the impact of the fulltime return to school. We would really appreciate it if you could ensure your child is in bed at a reasonable time each night. Research shows many positive benefits of sleep on children's attention, behaviour and mental health. We are grateful for your support with this.

The letters for Parents Evenings will be sent home next Monday; parents will be able to book an appointment online in the usual way and your child's class teacher will then send a Zoom appointment to you with your ten minute time slot. We will need your up-to-date email address and you will need to download the Zoom app onto a phone or computer. We look forward to updating you on your child's progress.

The staggered start and end of day times ensure the class bubbles are kept separate both inside and outside of school, which is essential during this current period of high Covid-19 cases. However, the Year 6 children are often waiting for over 15 minutes to come into school, so from 3rd November, Year 6 will come in to school at the slightly earlier time of **8:55am** and leave school at **3:20pm.** Please note these new times.


