The statement will show that you are either in credit or debit. If your statement says zero, there is nothing more you need to do. If you have a large outstanding debit on your account and are struggling to pay please email admin@montgomery-jun.essex.sch.uk and we can arrange a payment plan for you. If your child is in Year 3, their free school meal entitlement does not carry over from Year 2, you must reapply for free school meals if you think you are entitled.
