Headteacher Update

Dear Parents/Carers

It has been a pleasure to have all the children back in school, and even though for many pupils it has only been three weeks, they do seem ready for the Easter break.

We are sending your child home with this half term's Behaviour and Attitude report, plus a current attainment and progress report. Please do not be unduly alarmed if your child has not made expected progress during this very disrupted term. Through our assessments, we are aware of the gaps in learning due to the partial school closure and lockdown and will work hard in the Summer term to ensure your child makes robust progress. I have included dates of Parents' Evenings in the accompanying letter, so we would be grateful if these could be noted down in your diaries.

Your child has also been sent home with a booklet of activities designed to enhance their wellbeing. We hope that you will enjoy having some quality family time over the two week break.

Year 5 enjoyed their Road Safety sessions this week and learned how to cross the busy Baronswood Way safely. Further resources are available on the https://saferessexroads.org website.

We appreciate that the majority of parents park considerately and we are very grateful for that. However, there are still a minority of parents who put our children's lives at risk by parking dangerously. I have been contacted by Essex Police, who have asked that we notify all parents that Traffic Officers will be sent down to the school issuing Fixed Penalty notices for all parking violations. They will be attending on an ad hoc basis and offenders will be dealt with robustly.

Finally, a gentle reminder: if your child has a high temperature, a cough or has lost their sense of taste and/or smell, please ensure they take a PCR or lateral flow test. The latter can be ordered on https:// www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests If they test positive, it is vital that school is informed, including during the upcoming holidays (up until Wednesday 31st March) so that we can inform the rest of your child's bubble if there is a need to selfisolate. Please email me directly on head@montgomeryjun.essex.sch.uk should this be the case, so we can ensure the virus is not transmitted further in our community.

Can I take this opportunity to wish you all an enjoyable and safe Easter break and we look forward to welcoming your child back to school on Tuesday 13th April at their usual staggered start time.

If your child is in Year 3, their free school meal entitlement does not carry over from Year 2, you must reapply for free school meals if you think you are entitled. If you are entitled they will only back date your entitlement to the date you applied.
