Dear Parents/Carers

Following the announcement that the full easing of restrictions, put in place due to Covid 19, have been delayed, we are pleased that we are still able to continue with our school trips and visitors as part of our #MJS-best-term-ever.

On Monday the Year 3 children enjoyed a day at Layer Marney learning about life in the Bronze age. These visits are an important way to broaden the learning experiences of the children and we are keen to continue to implement these in the future. We do, however, need your support in financing these trips or they will become financially unviable. Thank you to all parents who sent in their donations for the trip.

Also on Monday, Year 6 accessed their workshops on Managing Change as they prepare for secondary school. The sessions focused on strategies to reduce worries and anxieties to which the children responded well.

Unfortunately the Colchester Military Pop-Up Band are unable to perform on Wednesday 23rd June due to the restrictions on the numbers allowed to attend public performances. This event has been cancelled by the MoD. Years 5 & 6 will be attending a Virtual Community Day on Wednesday 23rd June instead where they will access presentations from Essex Police, which will include learning about ways to prevent discrimination and prejudice.

From September, the National Curriculum is changing and all primary school aged children will be taught Health and Relationships Education. We have been working hard on our curriculum and our RSE policy so that it meets the needs of our children and families. We aim to teach the subject appropriately and sensitively and would like to consult with children and parents before our planning is finalised.
