Headteacher Update

Dear Parents/Carers

I hope you all enjoyed a lovely half term and had some quality time with your families.

As part of our Eco awareness drive, we have had some improvements to the school site during the half term week, including the fitting of 119 solar panels to our roof to reduce the school's use of power from the National Grid. When the sun is shining, over 80% of the power needed by the school can be generated by the solar panels so reducing our need for electricity and fossil fuels, which in turn reduces the emission of greenhouse gases, which slows down global warming. We will be focusing on these topics in a series of assemblies after Christmas to educate the children about ways to protect the planet and their futures.

During the holidays one of our families decided to clear up the verges outside school by collecting bags of litter, which had accumulated during half term (please see photo). As the children are aware, rubbish can be very dangerous to wildlife and, on occasions, even fatal. Please support us in making the community a safe and pleasant place to live by putting all litter into a bin, or taking it home to throw away. Thank you in advance for your support with this.



We have put some artwork completed by the children on display in the school hall, where it has caused great excitement this week. Please see the photo overleaf of the stunning artwork based on some of the children's favourite books. Thank you to Mrs Dignum for organising the project.
