Headteacher Update

Dear Parents/Carers



It has been such a busy time at Montgomery Junior School as the end of term and Christmas approach. Two of the three Christmas Carol Concerts have taken place in the garrison church and been recorded. The children sang and performed beautifully and their behaviour was excellent. Links will be available early next week for you to view the recordings at home; these will be password protected. In addition, the film company are offering DVDs of each show for sale at a cost of £7.50 plus VAT. The details of these will be available on the web link.

The Christmas parties will take place next week and on these days, children are allowed to wear their own clothes. The parties will take place on the following days: Year 3 on Monday 13th Dec; Year 6 on Tuesday 14th Dec; Year 4 on Wednesday 15th Dec and Year 5 on Thursday 16th Dec. Sensible shoes and warm coats are required on these days please as the children will still go out to play.

We have organised a virtual pantomime, Fizzy Finn Finds His Feet which the children will watch in class. The pantomine focuses on the themes of fear and bravery and how children can find their feet in a stormy world. We have also invited in Quantum Theatre to perform The Snow Queen on Tuesday 14th December; the show is a new adaptation of the original story and will provide the children with a real theatrical experience. Both of these are free of charge and funded totally by the school.

As the new restrictions come into place, we are asking that families lateral flow test their children twice per week to detect any positive cases. We would request that this takes place if your child has symptoms or is asymptomatic. We would also request that you carry out a lateral flow test before your child returns to school on Tuesday 5th January to ensure we do not have another Covid outbreak and have to potentially close bubbles.


