Headteacher Update

Dear Parents/Carers

I hope you had an enjoyable and relaxing Easter break. It has been lovely to welcome the children back for the Summer term 2022. We have been gradually lifting our Covid restrictions now that the guidance has changed and will be moving towards a complete return to normal as soon as possible. This will include more children eating in the hall together and the reintroduction of whole school assemblies.

The current guidance advises that if children have symptoms of a respiratory infection, including Covid-19, then they should remain at home if unwell or have a high temperature, but otherwise they are able to attend school. They can go back to school when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend. Testing children is no longer required, unless advised by a health professional, but should your child have a positive lateral flow test, it is recommended that they avoid contact with others and do not attend school for three full days.

Our Eco day saw children and staff wearing blue and green, as chosen by the School Council, to raise awareness of the need to protect our planet. The children chose the World Wildlife Fund as their charity; a total of £187.90 was raised and will be donated to this worthy cause. We thank you for your generosity.



Looking forward to the Queen's Platinum Jubilee, on Friday 27th May the children will take part in a range of different activities, including painting commemorative plates, to celebrate this historic occasion. This will also be an 'Own Clothes Day' when we will wear red, white and blue- no donations required. Further details will be sent out in a letter nearer the time.

Military Families' Activity Breaks (FAB)

Families' Activity Breaks (FAB) is a non-public funded, tri-service charity (registered charity number 1178108), providing fun and challenging activity camps around the UK for bereaved Military families. A FAB camp is a fully-paid* week away for bereaved military families; a welcome break to meet and socialise with others who have experienced a similar loss.



If your child is 19 years old or younger on the first day of camp, and has suffered the loss of a parent or family member while serving in the British Armed Forces, then you may be eligible for a FAB camp. Priority is given to families who fall into the above category, however, military families who have suffered a bereavement outside of this criteria will be considered by the committee on a case by case basis.

A small holding deposit is requested on confirmation of your place; this will be returned on arrival at the camp.

FAB Camps 2022 are in Newlands, Keswick, Cumbria: 29 Jul - 5 Aug 2022 and Stamford, Lincolnshire: 7 - 14 Aug 2022
